FOR THE PURPOSE OF establishing the Town of Riverdale Park's vision and commitment for arts and recreation.

WHEREAS, the Town established a Public Art Initiative in 2015 and in partnership with the Hyattsville CDC, created a rotating, year-round outdoor, town-wide sculpture gallery to bring public artwork to delight and enliven the Town, its residents and its visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Public Art Initiative also emphasizes the creation of promotional opportunities for local artists to extend their audience and their boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Town recognizes the need to provide the most attractive parks and recreation facilities for both adults and youth in our community to promote healthy lifestyles and sustainability; and

WHEREAS, parks and recreation programs and activities are vitally important to establishing and maintaining the quality of life in Riverdale Park, ensuring the health of citizens, and contributing to the economic and environmental well-being of our community; and

WHEREAS, Prince George's County provides Town residents with a variety of parks and recreation opportunities designed for all ages and interests, including popular recreation or athletic programs, special community events, senior activities, nature exploration, arts and cultural activities and volunteer opportunities; and


WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council are committed to operations, programs, initiatives, legislation and resources that further establish and nurture art and recreation;
