NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Riverdale Park do hereby establish this vision and commitment to Ethical Governance on behalf of the Town, and resolve to support and enact legislation and policies that further affirm the highest ethical and moral standards.
